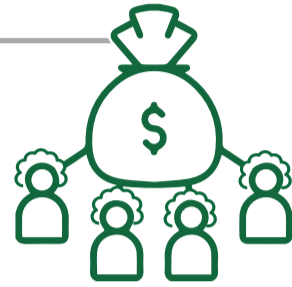

- Per-pupil site-share of central state and local expenditures



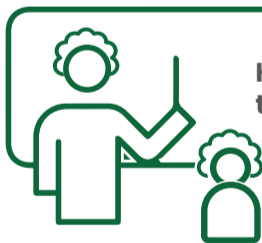
The district with the highest percentage of Black students who receive FRL received:
